**Description****Overall business processes:**

-We have multiple business models for cubework.

Business model #1: the seller will list their items on cubework and the buyers will purchase and we will have all the data saved on the platform.

Business model #2: the user will list their items on cubework and then we will take their listings and send them to productsUp, and then we will user productsUp to publish the data with many different formats to many different sales channels like Amazon, Kohls, Walmart, Belk, etc

In method #2 we will need to import the orders data and customer data from other sales channels which we will not have any of the payment info because it is saved on the sales channel itself.

But with method #1 we will be in control to have all the data from the buyer because the transaction happened on our platform and we should have all the data in there.

The ways for vendors to add data to BNP are as follows:

1. Fill out the vendor's bank information.
2. Having buyers purchase products from the vendor.

The ways for vendors to synchronize modifications are as follows:

1. Modifying the vendor's seller profile
2. Modifying the vendor's seller information.
3. Modifying the vendor's bank information.

Shipping methods

2 **Seller info**

Stores & pickup points

Fees

3 **Bank info**

The BNP accounting types currently consist of five categories: space, service, market, subscription, and payout.

However, there is no payout data available for the marketplace, so only the first four types will be recorded and synchronized to BNP.

1. For space type, the monetary data of space orders will be synchronized.
2. For service type, the monetary data of service orders will be synchronized.
3. For market type, the monetary data of market orders will be synchronized.
4. For subscription type, the monetary data deducted from the vendor plan will be synchronized.

1、 Does the payment type of order gets saved?

Yes

2、 Does payment info of credit card get saved and transferred from CS cart to BNP?

Yes, we have two payment methods: PayPal and credit card.

When customers place an order and make a payment on our website, the data is transmitted to BNP. If the payment method is credit card, the corresponding memo in BNP's data will display 'ModeOfPayment: Credit or debit card.' If the payment method is PayPal, it will display 'ModeOfPayment: PayPal Express Checkout.'



3、 Does the refund of orders gets saved in BNP?

No, we haven't discussed and implemented the refund part yet. Currently, refund records are not being transmitted to BNP.

4、 Payout Amount to the seller gets saved in BNP?

No, currently we do not allow sellers to withdraw funds, so there won't be such records yet.

5、 For subscription of seller to a monthly plan, we dont keep a record of the amount in BNP?

No, regarding the monthly plan charges, we have already generated data and transmitted it to BNP for recording. The entries in the 'memo' column on the BNP side, such as 'TradeType: subscription,' represent the records of our plan charges.

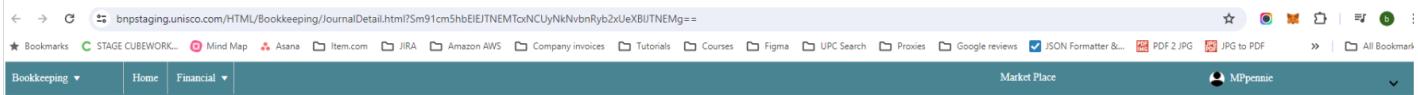

What is debit and credit? Is this order refunded?

These two data entries are designed by BNP. They are said to be an accounting method that requires recording debit and credit entries to ensure balance. We are not very familiar with the specifics, but they are not refund records. We haven't integrated the refund part yet.
